- ❖ Deadline to apply is January 17, 2025.
- ❖ Tour takes place in **June 2024**. Check ccemc.com/YouthTour for exact dates.
- Student must be a rising high school junior or senior.
- Students must reside in a residence receiving electric service from CCEC.
- Transportation to Raleigh must be provided the day before the tour to Washington, D.C.
- ❖ Youth Tourists are **required** to travel to and from Washington D.C. with the NCEMC Youth Tour group.
- Children and grandchildren of CCEC employees are not eligible to apply.
