

2023 CCEC FOUNDATION COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP (Instructions)

One student each from East Carteret, West Carteret, Croatan and Havelock high schools will be selected to receive a scholarship. The fifth recipient will be the next highest scoring applicant and may include students from other schools, such as Jones Senior High School, Early College EAST, Gramercy Christian School and home schools.

The scholarship program is open to students whose primary residence is on Carteret-Craven Electric Cooperative's lines. To qualify, the student must be a high school senior in the current graduating class and must be accepted at a 2-year community/technical college or 4-year college or university.

All applicants will be considered on the stated criteria, regardless of race, age, color, religion, sex, handicap or national origin.

Recipients are awarded up to \$4,000 total; \$500 each semester for eight semesters as long as the student maintains a 2.5 grade-point average (GPA).

The completed application must be received by the cooperative later than 5 p.m. on March 1, 2023.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. The student's primary residence **must** be on Carteret-Craven Electric Cooperative (CCEC) lines.
- 2. The student must be a high school senior in the current graduating class and must be accepted or applying at an accredited 2-year community/technical college or 4-year college or university.
- **3.** The applicant **cannot** be a close relative of a CCEC employee or director. Close relative is defined as a person who is related by consanguinity or affinity, to the third degree or less. That includes a person who is a spouse, child, grandchild, great-grandchild, parent, grandparent, great-grandparent, brother, sister, aunt, uncle, nephew, niece, great-aunt, great-uncle, great-nephew or great-niece by blood or adoption; an in-law; or half or step relative of the employee or director.

CRITERIA & JUDGING

CCEC will rule on eligibility of each applicant. All eligible applications will then be given to judges, who are not affiliated with the cooperative. They will grade each application separately based on a total of 100 points.

- 50% Need
- 25% Academic Achievement (based on transcripts and GPA; SAT, ACT and/or college placement test scores)
- 25% Extracurricular Activity (clubs, sports, projects, community, church, etc.)

APPLICATION PACKET (no staples, please)

- **1.** Application form
- 2. Current income verification documents, including FAFSA form or IRS 1040 form (pages 1&2) for current or past year, for all who provide you financial support. Mark through personal information, such as SSN, bank account information and birthdates.
- 3. Signed transcript or signed counselor verification on application.
- 4. SAT and/or ACT scores and/or college placement test scores.
- 5. Letter stating why you are applying and any extenuating circumstances that merit noting.
